- Health services

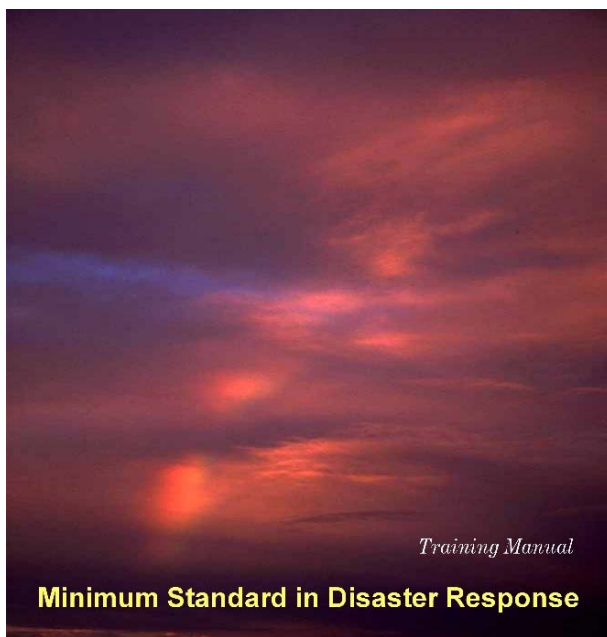
## Duration
